Irish and Irish American Studies Minor

We've surveyed the College for potential faculty and courses; we've conducted meetings with three deans; and we're plotting out an Irish and Irish American Studies minor. The program will be interdisciplinary, drawing on our varied expertise; and we will include lots of opportunities for study abroad. Already the College has established an exchange program with Queens University, Belfast, and we're beginning to explore ties to a university in or near Dublin and to another on the west coast. probably the National University of Ireland, Galway. While we're already teaching courses that will count towards the minor, the minor itself probably will not wend its way through the bureaucracy and make its way into the College Catalog until Fall 2015.
