Purpose: To establish a new ad hoc committee, to be known as the **Campus Sustainability Committee**, to serve as the student body's voice on sustainability issues and to synthesize and oversee any and all SGA sustainability related endeavors.

Whereas, There are multiple bodies throughout the college that deal with issues pertaining to campus sustainability, none of which provide significant access to the student body, nor offer a collective voice to those within the student body.

Whereas, The SGA Senate, as the representatives of the student body, offers tremendous credibility to the initiatives it supports, and projects it undertakes.

Whereas, It is the goal of the SGA to provide voice and action to the wills of the students, and to assert student interests throughout the campus in all issues where student interest may lie or where students take stake in the consequences of decisions made.

Whereas, Section I of the SGA Constitution states that it is the duty of the Senate to create committees as it sees fit.

Therefore: BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING:

Section I: The SGA Senate, assembled, shall establish an ad hoc legislative committee bearing the name The Campus Sustainability Committee, to be dissolved upon the adjournment of the final Senate session of the 2010-2011 academic year, unless extended by act of legislation before that point.

Section II: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT (UPON PASSAGE) BY THE STUDENT SENATE SITTING IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE SIGNATURE OF THE STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT.
