1 2 3 A Resolution SR-002 4 **Presented by Senator Elliott Wright** 5 of the 6 **College of Charleston Student Government Association** 7 On this Sixteenth Day of February, 2010 8 9 10 **Purpose:** To demonstrate student support for the inclusion of a student representative on the College of Charleston Board of Trustees. 11 12 The College of Charleston Board of Trustees consists of seventeen 13 Whereas: members, sixteen of whom hold voting rights. 14 15 Whereas: Two members represent each of the six congressional districts in South 16 Carolina and are elected by the General Assembly for terms of four 17 years each. Whereas: Three at-large members are elected by the General Assembly for terms 18 19 of four years each. 20 Whereas: One at-large member is appointed by the Governor of South Carolina. Whereas: 21 The Governor, or his designee, serves as an ex-officio member. 22 Whereas: Many colleges and universities include student representatives on their boards of trustees. 23 24 Whereas: This ensures the permanent, direct expression of the beliefs of the 25 student body to the school administrations. 26 Whereas: Cornell University permits the election, by the student body, of two 27 student representatives to its Board of Trustees.

1 2 3	Whereas:	The University of Illinois permits the election, by the student bodies of its three campuses, of three student representatives to its Board of Trustees.
4 5	Whereas:	The College of William and Mary permits the election, by the student body, of two student representatives to its Board of Visitors.
6 7 8	Whereas:	Washington University of St. Louis permits the election, by the graduate student body, of two student representatives to its Board of Trustees.
9 10	Whereas:	James Madison University permits the election, by the student body, of one student representative to its Board of Trustees.
11 12	Whereas:	It is essential that the student body has adequate representation to the College's administration.
13 14 15 16 17	Whereas:	South Carolina House Bill 4244 is currently under review by the State Legislature and seeks to create an additional position on the College of Charleston Board of Trustees, with full rights, to be filled at the discretion of the College of Charleston Alumni Association Board of Directors.
18 19	Whereas:	This bill can still be amended to include the creation of a position on the College of Charleston Board of Trustees for student representation.
20 21 22 23	Therefore:	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING:
24 25 26	Section I:	The student body of the College of Charleston supports the inclusion of a student representative position on the Board of Trustees.
