9 clubs and organizations in monetary distributions.

10 **WHEREAS,** it is the duty of a Senator, as expressed in our bylaws, “to serve as a
11 representative of the student body” throughout the university and the community.

12 **WHEREAS,** it is a function of the Student Government Association to allocate
13 monetary funds to registered and sanctioned student organizations throughout the college
14 campus.

15 **WHEREAS,** the support of student organizations is vital to the success of an active and
16 healthy student life.

17 **THEREFORE,** BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT
18 GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE
19 FOLLOWING:

20 **SECTION I:** the Student Government Association of the College of Charleston
21 allocate up to the amount of **\$1460** to the student organization, *Collegiate DECA* for
22 the purpose of sending four students to the International Career Development
23 Conference.

1 **SECTION II:** the total amount of money to be allocated will be distributed in the
2 following manner. The distribution of those funds will be at the discretion of the
3 Treasurer, Allocations Committee and Coordinator for Business Services.

- 4 1.\$600: registration fee for four students (\$150 each)
- 5 2. \$758: lodging (5 nights)
- 6 3.\$102: gas

7 **\$1460: amount of money going towards the entire event**

Purpose: To amend the bylaws of the SGA

Whereas: The phrase “involuntary resignation” is used to denote one’s forced removal from office in sections 100.013a, 100.013d, 100.013e, 200.004, 301.001j, 500.004j, 500.015, 600.015, 700.009, and 800.009

Whereas: Replacing “involuntary resignation” with “removal from office” more directly identifies the action that would be taking place under the circumstances described in these sections

Therefore: BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING:

Section I: The phrase “involuntary resignation” in sections 100.013a, 100.013d, 100.013e, 200.004, 301.001j, 500.004j, 500.015, 600.015, 700.009, and 800.009 shall be replaced by “removal from office.”

Section II: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT (UPON PASSAGE) BY THE STUDENT SENATE SITTING IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE SIGNATURE OF THE STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT.

- Whereas:** Scheduling conflicts prevent the designated requirement of Section 600.009 from regularly occurring
- Therefore:** BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING:
- Section I:** **Strike section 600.009**
- Section II:** THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT (UPON PASSAGE) BY THE STUDENT SENATE SITTING IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE SIGNATURE OF THE STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT.
