1 FB-18 2 Presented by Senator Rapachietta 3 of the College of Charleston Student Government Association On this Eleventh Day of October, 2011 6 7 PURPOSE, To amend the bylaws of the SGA. 8 9 WHEREAS, the current Section 1700.02 reads "The internal budget of Student 10 Government Association shall be made in the spring semester preceding the academic school 11 year for which that budget shall be in use." 12 WHEREAS, budgets are now allocated on a semester instead of an annual basis. 13 THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT 14 GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE 15 FOLLOWING: 16 **SECTION I:** Strike "in the spring semester preceding the academic school year for which that budget shall be in use" from section 1700.01. 17 18 SECTION II: Insert "the semester prior to its intended use in accordance with the budget deadlines stated in the Compass." after "shall be made." 19 20 SECTION III: Section 1700.02 will then read, "The internal budget of the Student 21 Government Association shall be made the semester prior to its intended use in 22 accordance with the budget deadlines stated in the Compass." 23 SECTION IV: THIS BILL SHALL TAKE EFFECT (UPON PASSAGE) BY THE STUDENT SENATE SITTING IN GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND THE SIGNATURE OF 24 THE STUDENT BODY PRESIDENT. 25

8	PURPOSE, To amend the bylaws of the SGA.
9	WHEREAS, the current bylaws are outdated and do not reflect the current budget
10	procedures.
11	WHEREAS, Section 1700.02 currently reads "There shall be an Internal Budget Hearing
12	The purpose of this hearing is for the newly elected Executive Council (that is the Executive
13	Council which will be in Office the following academic school year) to create the operational
14	budget for the upcoming school year. This Internal Budget Hearing shall take place no later
15	than the third week in April."
16	WHEREAS, Section 1700.02a currently reads "Committee Chairpersons from the curren
17	and upcoming academic school years will meet to write a proposed budget for their
18	committees. The newly elected Executive Council will hold an Internal Budget Hearing for the
19	Committees, during which the newly appointed Committee Chairperson shall present the
20	proposed Committee budget for review. The Executive Council will allocate funds to each
21	Committee based on this hearing. Final distribution of funds is at the discretion of the
22	Executive Council."
23	WHEREAS, Section 1700.02b currently reads "The current and upcoming Treasurers will
24	meet and write a proposed budget for the Executive Council. This budget shall cover
25	operational costs of the Student Government Association and any internal Senate-wide
26	spending. Types of items that should be included in this Executive Council budget are (but are

- 1 not limited to) phone bills, name badges, senate retreats, new computer, and print cartridges.
- 2 This budget shall be presented to the Executive Council for review, during the Internal Budget
- 3 Hearing. The Executive Council will allocate funds to this budget based on the hearing. Final
- 4 distribution of funds is at the discretion of the Executive Council."
- 5 WHEREAS, it is impossible for upcoming chair persons to take part in the budgeting
- 6 process due to current budget timing.
- 7 THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT
- 8 GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE
- 9 FOLLOWING:
- 10 SECTION I: Strike sections 1700.02.
- 11 **SECTION II:** Strike section 1700.02a.
- 12 SECTION III: Strike section 1700.02b.
- 13 SECTION IV: Section 17002.02 will then read "The Student Government Association's
- 14 Internal Budget will be presented to the Allocations Committee for review during Budget
- 15 Hearings each semester. "
- 16 SECTION V: Section 17002.02a will then read "The current committee chair persons will
- 17 be responsible for writing a proposed budget for their committees. The proposals will be
- 18 due by the date set by the Student Body Treasurer. Each committee chairperson will
- 19 present his or her section of the Internal Budget to the Treasurer who will then present the
- 20 entire Internal Budget to the Allocations Committee. The final distribution of the funds is
- 21 at the discretion of the Allocation Committee."
- 22 SECTION VI: Section 1700.02b will then read "The Student Body Treasurer is
- 23 responsible for writing a proposed budget for Executive Council with the assistance of the
- 24 other Council members. This budget shall cover operational costs of the Student Government
- 25 Association and any internal Senate-wide spending. Types of items that should be included in

this Executive Council budget are (but are not limited to) phone bills, name badges, senate
retreats, new computer, and print cartridges. The final distribution of the funds is at discretion
of the Allocation Committee."
