Whereas, The Allocations Committee strongly believes it would be more fiscally responsible for sanctioned organizations to use money that have already been allocated in their budget rather than applying for Contingency Funds.

Whereas, Page 2 of the Compass states, "Some of the policies, procedures and other information outlined in this Handbook may change throughout the year."

Therefore, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING:

Section I: The Senate supports the Allocations Committee with its decision to allow sanctioned organizations to submit Change of Requests regardless of their original budgeted category.

Section II: The Senate supports that this change be reviewed during Compass revisions for the Summer 2012.

Purpose, To appoint Matthew Vaveris to Senior Senator.

Whereas, There are currently numerous vacancies in the Senior class.

Whereas, Section 1100.002 of the bylaws states that, "In the event a vacancy occurs within the Senate because of resignation or failure to petition for office, the vacancy shall be filled by individuals who have completed the requirements of the petition and release waiver. The candidate must be nominated by a Senator of the class in which the vacancy occurs and shall be approved by a 2/3 vote of the Senate."

Therefore, BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING:

Section I: Matthew Vaveris shall be appointed to the position as a Senior Senator with all the duties and responsibilities of the position.
