STUDENT GOVERNMENT 1 ASSOCIATION 2 FB-52 3 Presented by Senator Clark of the 5 College of Charleston Student Government Association 6 On this Twenty-ninth Day of November, 2011 7 8 Purpose, to amend the bylaws of the SGA. 9 Whereas, currently, there are over 66 student organizations at the College and only 4 10 members of the Allocations Committee, excluding Treasurer Rozansky. 11 Whereas, currently, this bylaw is not enforced. 12 Whereas, this bylaw is inefficient, seeing that each member is supposed to act as a 13 liaison to one of our many student organizations, in order to oversee proper use of allocated funds and better our relationship with the few participating 14 15 organizations. 16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE SENATE OF THE STUDENT Therefore, 17 GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION IN REGULAR SESSION 18 ASSEMBLED, THE FOLLOWING: 19 Section I: Strike section 1400.003a from the bylaws, which currently reads, "Each 20 member of allocations committee shall be assigned to an on-campus 21 organization as liaisons of the Student Government Association, and be 22 responsible for attending the meetings of said organization. These liaisons 23 will help to ensure that funding is allocated appropriately as well as to

encourage collaboration of on campus organizations. Within 24 hours of
