

Add *meebo* Chat to Your Blog or Web Page

What is *meebo*?

<http://www.meebo.com>

meebo is an open source, in-browser instant messaging program that supports multiple IM services.

When logged into *meebo*, you can chat with all of your visitors in real time and access your favorite IM networks including *Yahoo!*, *Messenger*, *.NET Messenger Service*, *Google Talk*, *AIM*, *ICQ* and *Jabber* all in one place.



Where can I use *meebo*?

You can put *meebo* on any web page where you can embed html and a flash widget. This includes most blogging platforms (i.e. *Wordpress*, *Blogger*), and social networks (i.e. *MySpace*) and any other web page you design and manage.

Setting up your *meebo me* Widget

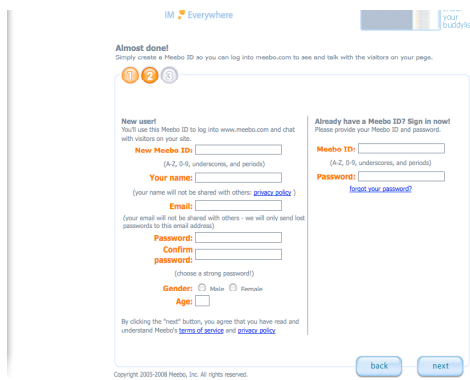
The *meebo me!* widget allows you chat with anyone who comes to your blog or web page. Visitor's show up in your *meebo buddylist* so you can strike up a conversation, answer questions, or just keep tabs on guests. You can also publish your online status so visitors can see if you're available when they visit your site.

Add meebo Chat to Your Blog or Web Page

- 1 **Point your browser to the *meebome!* web site:**
<http://www.meebome.com/>
- 2 **Click the *Get Started* button in the top right corner of the web page.**
- 3 **Complete the web form that asks for a widget title (i.e., Chat), and your username (your name). Select a widget (regular), and choose a color theme.**
- 4 **Click next.**
- 5 **Complete the web form that asks for your *Meebo ID*, Your Name, your Email address, your Password, Confirm your Password, Gender, & Age.**
- 6 **Click next.**



- 7 **Copy and paste the Code into your *blog or web page*.**
- 8 **Sign into *meebo.com* to chat with all of your visitors in real time.**

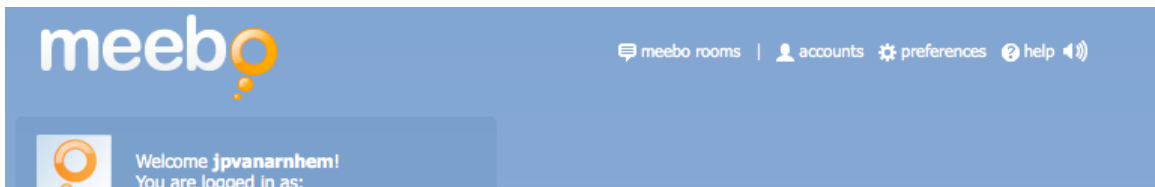

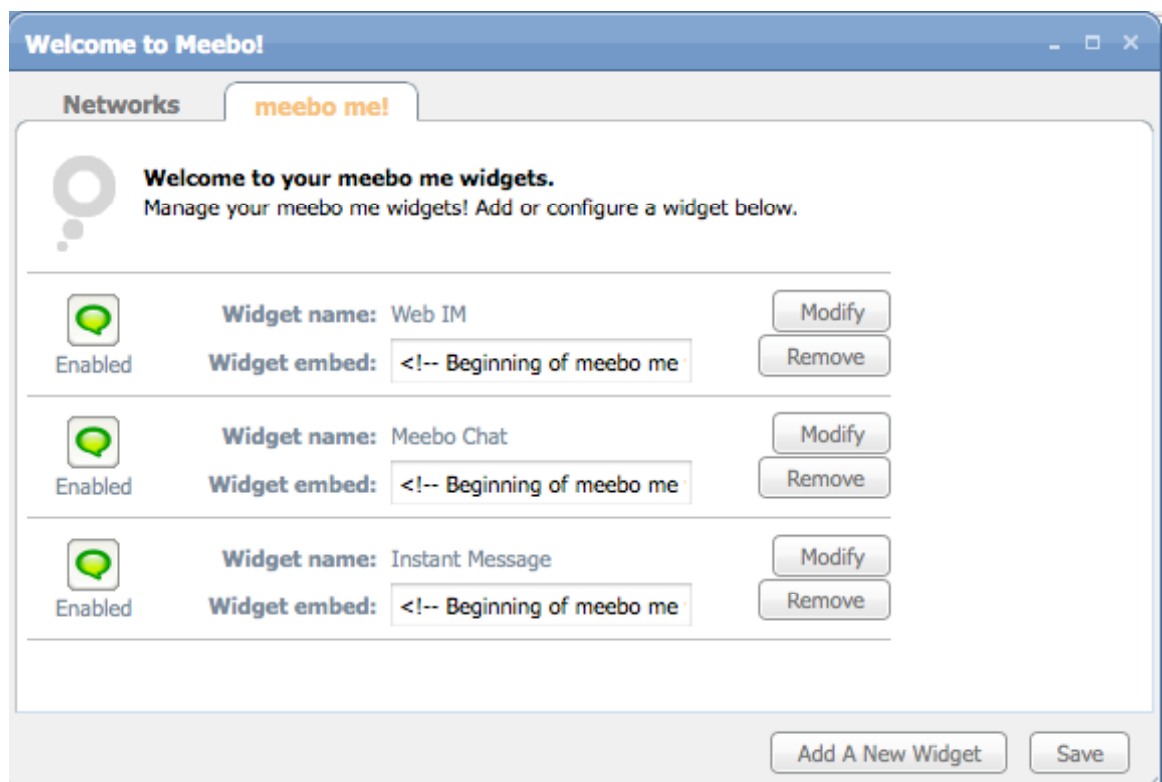
Add *meebo* Chat to Your Blog or Web Page

I want to put my meebo me widget on another page. Where can I find my widget code?

1. **Login** to your *meebo* account (<http://www.meebo.com>)
2. **Click** on the **Preferences** link at the top of your *meebo* page.



3. **Select** the *meebo me!* widget tab.
4. **Click** on the **widget embed text** box to **copy the embed code**.



5. **Copy and paste the code** to your web page.
