Description: Using the paramedic method, which helps eliminate the over-use of prepositional phrases, forms of the verb "to be," passive verb constructions, redundancies, and pretentious diction, revise the following sentences.

- --For each sentence, first underline the prepositional phrases.
- --Then, circle forms of the verb "to be."
- --Then, figure out "who's kicking who"—who's doing what action?
- --Finally, rewrite each sentence underneath the original. Use simple, active verbs and get the actor up front. Eliminate wordy wind-ups. Make your sentences as clear, simple, and direct as possible!

Sample:

Original Sentence

Some <u>of the groups</u> who are <u>in opposition</u> to the death penalty feel there is doubt <u>about</u> <u>its morality</u>.

Revision

Some groups who oppose the death penalty doubt its morality.
